Part 1

John 1:1

-John says in the beginning was the Word; Genesis says, "in the beginning God". Scripture confirms itself: the Word is God. It is important that we understand the Word is God Himself.

Psalm 119:9

-We hide the Word in our spiritual hearts. We cannot do this unless we know the Word. One can tell if the Word is hidden in your heart by how you behave and what you say.

We must know what the Word says. Paul invites us to study the Word (2 Timothy 2:15). Let the Word get down on the inside of you, that you can rightly divide the Word of truth.

The Holy Spirit

John 15:1-2

-Are we bringing fruit in, telling others about Jesus? Life is a journey. On that journey, you run into things. Bad things happen to everyone, but if the Word is hidden in our heart, we will know how to handle what the situation presents.

2 Corinthians 5:19

-We must understand that we do not serve three Gods: God is one (Deuteronomy 6:4). The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are one.

John 14:15-16; Luke 24:46-53; John 15:26; John 16:16-24; Acts 2:1-4

-Jesus was preparing the disciples for His departure. He said that He would not leave them alone, but would send the Holy Spirit who would help, guide, counsel, testify to, and lead them. It is important that we understand the function and the work of the Holy Spirit. It is the power of God come to aid us in the work He has called to do. (Acts 1:8; Luke 24:49).
